WHAT TO EXPECT FOR YOUR STUDENT

When your student first logs in to Imagine Español, they will take a test to show the program what they already know. Be sure they complete the test on their own because their answers will ensure the personalized learning path will be tailored to their needs. Some questions will be easy and others will be harder. If your student needs to log out before they're done with the test, they'll pick up where they left off next time.


RACK UP THE BOOSTER BITS!

Stay connected to your student's teacher

Checking in with your student's teacher can help keep everyone on track, and the teacher can show you how to monitor your student's work at home. We recommend connecting with the teacher to review growth metrics, test results, performance predictions, and skill areas where your student needs extra support or more of a challenge.

Create a way for your student to excel at home

At-home support and encouragement are valuable. Try these tips to keep your student engaged and focused:

- Choose a comfortable, distraction-free space as a work area for your student
- Create a plan, such as 'focus time' and 'break time,' to help them connect and succeed
- Make sure your student has Wi-Fi and a charged device, such as a laptop, tablet, or smartphone
- · Show interest in what your student is learning about with questions like, "What activities did you get to play today?" or "Can we sing one of the songs from your lesson together?"
