

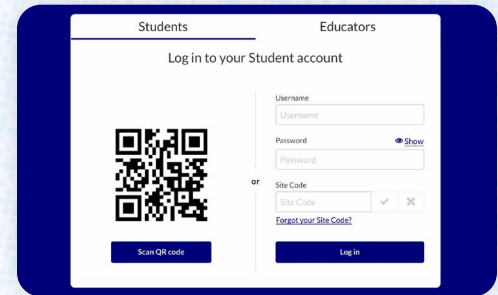
Family Support for Imagine+ Math

GET STARTED!

Help your student log in to [Imagine+ Math*](#) with the username and password provided by their school. The school may also provide a login code to enter. If your district uses a single sign-on portal (SSO), follow the instructions from your student's teacher. Now you're ready to make the most of the following tips to support your student.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Your student's school may use NWEA MAP or Renaissance Star test results to determine their individual learning path. Or, the first time your student uses Imagine+ Math, they may take an Imagine Assessment test to decide their individual learning path. In either case, you can see their learning path whenever they're logged in, including the topics they will cover to build their math skills. By clicking the star or navigating to 'Student > My Progress' in the top right corner, you can review your student's level, logged time, and lessons passed. Select 'View Details' to see year-to-date data.

KEEPING TRACK OF PROGRESS

Your student will love showing you their hard work in Imagine+ Math. Consider reviewing the My Progress page weekly to encourage your student in their learning journey.

- Write down goals — track active minutes or lessons completed each week. Reward your student for reaching their goals.
- Encourage your student by looking through their "My Stuff" page together. This is where Imagine+ Math provides digital rewards like avatars and backgrounds. The more your student works along their learning path, the more their "My Stuff" inventory will grow.
- Scroll through your student's learning path and discuss upcoming topics to prepare them for what lies ahead.
- Review your student's performance with their teacher. Discuss their overall progress, growth, and test results, as well as any skill areas where they may be struggling



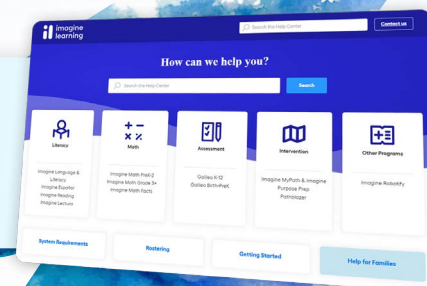

- Create a comfortable, distraction-free space as a work area for your student
- Create a plan, such as "focus time" and "break time," to help them connect and succeed
- Make sure your student has Wi-Fi and a charged device, such as a laptop or tablet
- Show interest in what your student is learning about with questions like, "What did you focus on today?" or "What questions do you have about the lesson?"
- Review any worksheets or lessons assigned by your student's teacher
