Click the Assessment Profile (speedometer) icon next to the student's name.

The most recent MAP test taken by the student appears at the top left. Use the drop-down to view other tests.

View the blue RIT Range indicator, the standard error range indicators, and the grade level.

Goals are listed under the test menu. Click the goal name to expand the goal and view the topics. You may consider removing goals and topics for which the student scored above the RIT Range. Click the red circle to do so.

Use the eye icon to preview the learning path. You can also preview a lesson by clicking the eye icon next to it. Hover over the i to see the goal and topic alignments for the lesson.

When you are ready to assign the learning path, review the teacher of record and make any needed changes, select the appropriate term, and then click Create and Enroll.
